Brown Act Invitation for Public Comment

No cards to speak were submitted from the public.

Donna Jean Darby read the email from Dr. William Crowe, from the University of Georgia who compiled data on the fundraising efforts of 850 two year colleges and their Foundations. Based on the IRS 990 for tax years 2009 thru to 2012, our Foundation in terms of total assets ranked 26th in the top 100 and in terms of annual funds raised, we ranked 64th in the top 100.

Treasurer Report – Financials Review – Jim Hummer

Jim gave the overview of the October financials. He Informed the Board that we are still working on simplifying the reports.

Foundation Board Items

Lisa Howell, Vice President of Administrative Services and Ex-Officio member of our Board was introduced by Donna Jean.

30 for 30 Challenge Campaign

Hand-out was given to board members indicating the \$3Million campaign and the different program goals. Donna Jean expects 100% Board participation. The College priorities list was discussed and will be a great help with the campaign. Jim Hummer asked that each member email or call him with prospective donors. Several members asked for a "cheat sheet" which gives some basic stats such as: % of COD graduates working at CV hospitals. Dr. Kinnamon will draft something for next meeting.
