Elena announced that we have 41 reservations, and others on the committee added more names, bringing the total registrations now to 46. Elena will update her RSVP list and will send to Marge. It was decided to ask President Hope and VP Rod Garcia to speak jointly about the Jordan Schnitzer art museum. The main presentation for the luncheon will be Bert Bitanga speaking about the College's "tiny house" architectural program. He will bring one of the tiny houses to the luncheon for attendees to tour after the program concludes. Pledge cards will be distributed at each seat requesting donations to the architectural program. The overall fundraising goal for the day is \$15,000. Staff will arrive approximately 10:30am to set up.

5.3 Season 2024 to 2025 Events

It was decided to do four events next year: a "Welcome Back Tea" event at a restaurant in October; a mixer in late January; another mixer in March; and the Spring into Summer luncheon in April. We will request a \$5,000 grant from the Barker Foundation to be split between the Welcome Back Tea (\$2,500) and the two mixers (\$1,250 each). A list of possible host restaurants and country clubs was identified, and the members will discuss these further as we get closer to next season.

5.4 Update on Learning to Lead Publicity Plan

Publicity will now be spearheaded by the Foundation staff since Theresa Maggio's departure. We will post opportunities on the Handshake app, and contact ASCOD, the Pride Center, plEdge, and the Veterans' center.

5.5 Update on Hospitality trip to Japan in March 2024

The College's Hospitality program is making another trip to Japan later this spring and they would like us to once again provide backpacks for the students.
